Element 1 – Safe school environment

Goal – ABC will maintain and increase the perception of a safe school environment in all its schools.

1. Review, update, and implement crisis preparedness plan on a system wide basis and at each school/	a. Conduct staff training in crisis and safety meeting bilingual needs b. Develop system-wide emergency response team c. Practice crisis plan with mock emergency training d. Provide in-service training for crisis intervention for all school police and school liaisons with mental health provider program; prepare CMP charts e. Install internal antennas so police radios work in “dead zones”.	10% increase in perception by staff and students of safe environment	Results from state’s annual drug use survey for students Climate survey pre and post for teachers, staff, parents

Goal – Delay the onset, discontinue use, and/or reduce the incidents of alcohol, other drugs, and violent behavior in schools.

Objective	Strategy	Outcome/Impact	Indicator
1. Dropout prevention	a. Expelled school alternatives with drug education and counseling b. Suspended Student Alternatives with drug education and counseling.	10% decrease in disruptive and violent incidences on school campuses.	Set benchmarks pre and review records, design reporting form to be used consistently throughout the district for tracking incidences.
